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### Grant Requirements and Guidelines

- Qualifying organizations must be within Jacobsen Seeds territory of Iowa, Nebraska, South Dakota, or Minnesota
  - Grant uses must be consistent with the values and mission of Jacobsen Seed
  - Jacobsen Seed will not give critiques of applications submitted
  - Jacobsen Seed will select and award grants under committee review
  - Organizations will be notified of selection on or before August 1st, 2021.
  - Upon selection, organizations are required to submit a group photo and press release to local paper as well as a copy to Jacobsen Seed.
  - Selected organizations will be invited to the Jacobsen Field Showcase in Ulmer, IA on Tuesday, August 24th 2021 to receive their check.
  - Selected organizations are asked to invite a Jacobsen Seed Representative to come speak at an FFA meeting, career day, or other event to share Jacobsen Seed's history and mission.
